

The Hive is Alive!

A beehive is a home for a colony of bees that all work together to survive.



What's the buzz on bees?

Each hive has one queen. She is much larger than the other bees.
Can you spot the queen bee?

Worker honeybees drink nectar from flowers and turn it into honey inside their bodies.

When a bee finds a good source of nectar, it flies back to the hive and does a **special dance**. This dance tells the other bees where to go.

When bees travel from blossom to blossom to find nectar, they **pick up pollen on their hairy bodies**.

When the bee goes to another flower, some of the pollen from the first flower sticks to the second flower.

The flowers get pollinated, and that helps new flowers, fruits and vegetables grow.

Our eyes have a single lens, but bee eyes have many.
